Aer Lingus offers three daily, non-stop flights to Ireland from Boston's Logan Airport in summer 2024 and is ready to fly visitors on their next adventure.

to Ireland, including daily flights from Hartford, Connecticut, the restart of Minneapolis-St. Paul to Dublin route, starting on April 29 and direct flights from Denver, Colorado to Dublin for the first time, starting on May 17.

SAVE TIME WITH U.S. PRE-CLEARANCE

When flying transatlantic with Aer Lingus, visitors also benefit from U.S. Customs and Border pre-clearance at both Dublin and Shannon airports. This means that passengers flying back to the U.S. are cleared for U.S. immigration and full U.S. customs and agriculture controls.
