The Tanglewood grounds have long been a prestigious stop for the world's best conductors and performers of classical music, baroque, folk, country, world music, and more. A special feature of Tanglewood is its beautiful 500-acre campus. Listeners are welcome to bring lawn chairs or blankets and have a picnic on the grass as their favorite artists perform. Tanglewood is both casual and classy, and the easygoing atmosphere and the beauty of the surrounding hills makes it a popular setting for company retreats, family reunions, wedding parties, and various group activities.
